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A sentence (a complete unit of thought) made of:

Subject


The subject is usually a noun—a word (or phrase) that names a person, place, or thing.

Verb

usually follows the subject and identifies an action or a state of being.

object

objects *receive* the action and usually follow the verb

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Present simple



 every day / week / year



"the "ing" rule"




Present continuous




- We use this rule when we do something right now.

Past simple




- ☐ We use this rule when we did something in the past and finished.

- yesterday, a week (month, year) ago, last (month, year, weekend, Monday) night, the day before yesterday, two days (months, years) a CS CamScanner






