• For the weather: we wear warm clothes when it's cold, and light clothes when it's hot to stay comfortable; for special occasions: we dress differently for special occasions, like parties, weddings or other celebrations; for sports: we wear different sports clothes depending on the sport we're playing; for protection: clothes can protect us from the sun, snow, rain, and from getting injured; for culture and style: we wear clothes to reflect our culture, traditions or personal style




