Lunch

Dinner

Before I go to sleep, I eat dinner while watching TV.





Restaurant

EVERY WEEKEND, I HAVE LUNCH WITH MY FAMILY AT THE RESTAURANT.

Cheap:

-We like to go to Pizza Palace restaurant because it's cheap and good at the same time.

Expensive:

-This market is very expensive, it's better to look for a cheaper one to buy our needs.





Waiter - serve

WHEN WE GO TO THE RESTAURANT, THE WAITER SERVES FOOD FOR US.

Delicious:

My mom cooks delicious food.

Yet and already

GRAMMAR TIME!

Yet:

1- used at the end of the sentence or question.

EXAMPLES:

- I HAVEN'T DONE MY HOMEWORK YET.
- THE GAME HASN'T STARTED YET.
- HAVE YOU EATEN YOUR LUNCH YET?
- DID THE TEACHER START THE LESSON YET?

Yet:

2-used with have not.

EXAMPLE:

I HAVE NOT HAD LUNCH YET.
I HAVEN'T SLEPT YET.

Yet:

3-used with questions.

EXAMPLES:

HAVE YOU CLEANED YOUR ROOM <u>YET?</u>
HAS IT STOPPED RAINING <u>YET?</u>

Already:

1- used in the middle of the sentence.

*EXAMPLE:

I HAVE **ALREADY** EATEN MY LUNCH.

Already:

2-used before the main verb.

EXAMPLE:

SHE HAS **ALREADY DONE** HER HOMEWORK.

Already:

3-used after has/have.

EXAMPLE:

HE HAS ALREADY BRUSHED HIS TEETH.
