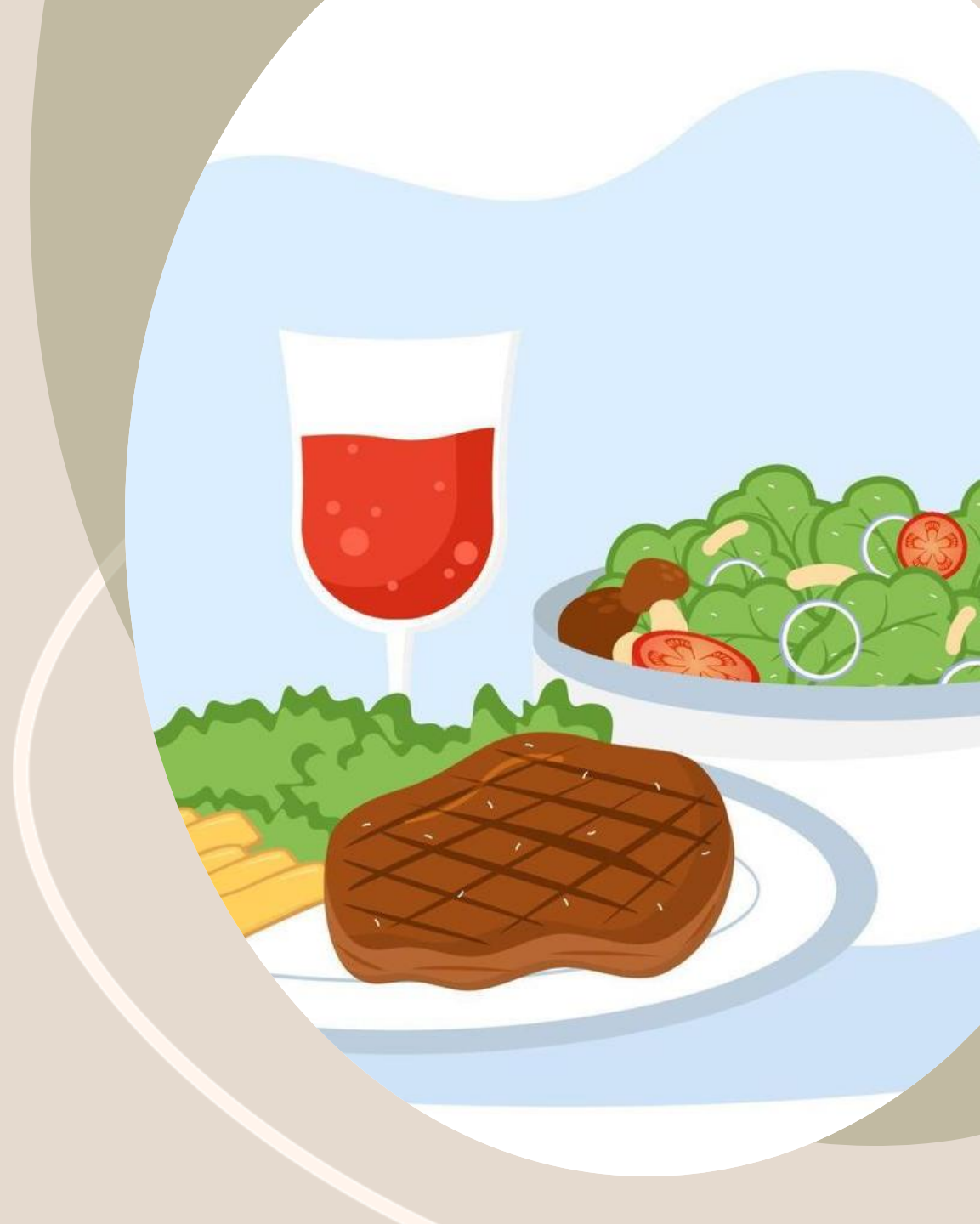

# Yet:

1- used at the end of the sentence or question.

## EXAMPLES:

- I HAVEN'T DONE MY HOMEWORK YET.
- THE GAME HASN'T STARTED YET.
- HAVE YOU EATEN YOUR LUNCH YET?
- DID THE TEACHER START THE LESSON YET?



Yet:

2- used with have not.

EXAMPLE:

I HAVE NOT HAD LUNCH YET.

I HAVEN'T SLEPT YET.



Yet:

3- used with questions.

EXAMPLES:

HAVE YOU CLEANED YOUR ROOM YET?

HAS IT STOPPED RAINING YET?

3- used after has/have.

EXAMPLE:

HE HAS ALREADY BRUSHED HIS TEETH.
