

Have you ever walked for a whole day? Or a week?
What about a whole year? Did you know that there are
long-distance paths all around the world that are thousands
of kilometres long? The Appalachian Trail, in the USA, is over 3,500
kilometres long! Can you imagine how long it takes to walk that path?



This path runs
for 1,014
kilometres
around the
south-west coast
of the UK, so you
are never far away
from cliffs and the
ocean. Most people walk it in
small sections, but if you've
got a few months, you can

→ Wadi Shab (Oman)

This path is much shorter — you can do it in half a day! But if you walk to Wadi Shab, you can see the beautiful blue of the water and even swim there. It is not an easy walk, but it ends at an amazing cave. You can even swim through the cave to a waterfall!



The Toubkal Summit Path (Morocco)

This path is only
28 kilometres long,
but it is not easy! It
takes two days and
takes you to the top of
Mount Toubkal. This is
North Africa's highest
mountain, at more than
4,100 metres. If you
like mountains, this is
the path for you! The
views from the top are
spectacular!


