



# ما هي الضمائر غير المحددة في اللغة الإنجليزية وكيف تُستخدم؟

• الضمائر غير المحددة ( (indefinite pronouns)) هي كلمات تُستخدم للإشارة إلى أشخاص أو أشياء أو أماكن غير محددة في اللغة الإنجليزية. تُستخدم هذه الضمائر عندما لا نتحدث عن شيء محدد أو عند التعبير عن أحكام عامة. مثال:

### (Jim was here - جیم کان هنا!)

في الجملة أعلاه، لا يوجد ضمير غير محدد والإجابة على السؤال "من كان هنا؟".

- Someone was here! شخص ما کان هنا!)
- هل نعرف من هو "الشخص" المذكور في الجملة؟ هذا هو عمل الضمير غير المحدد؛ يُشير إلى شخص غير محدد.
