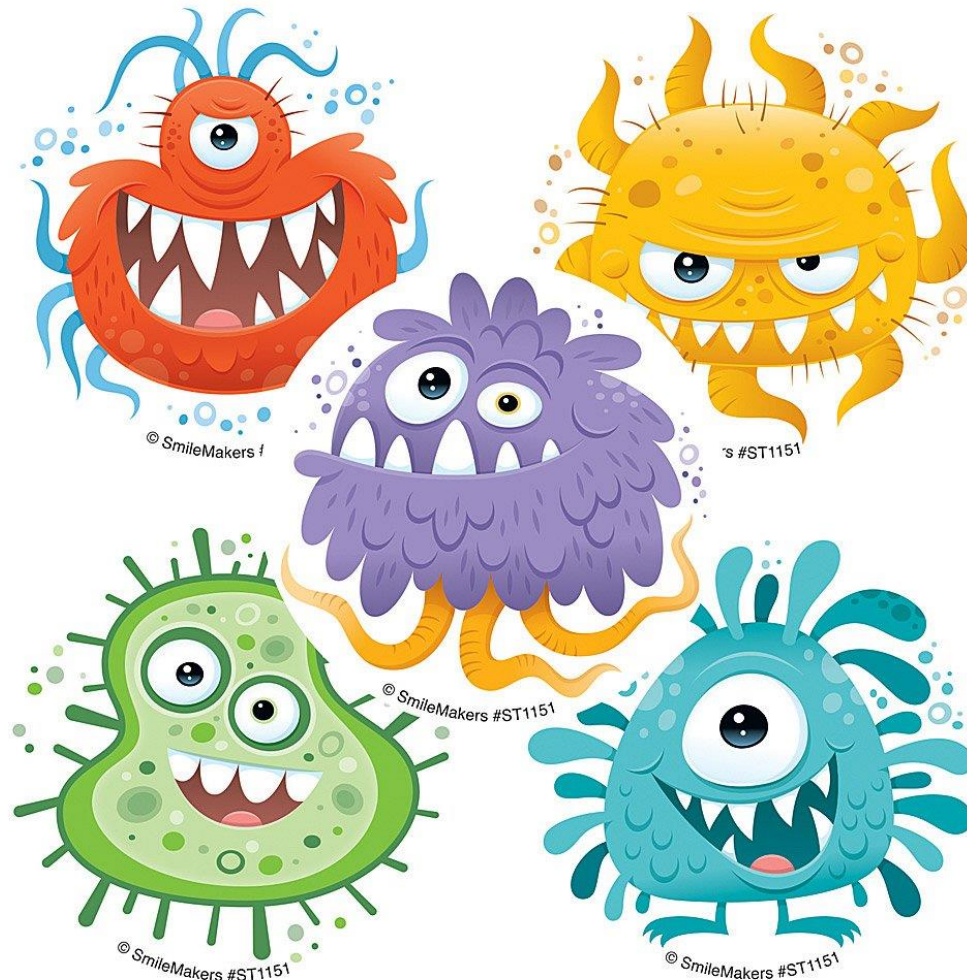
# Vaccine:

# Germ:

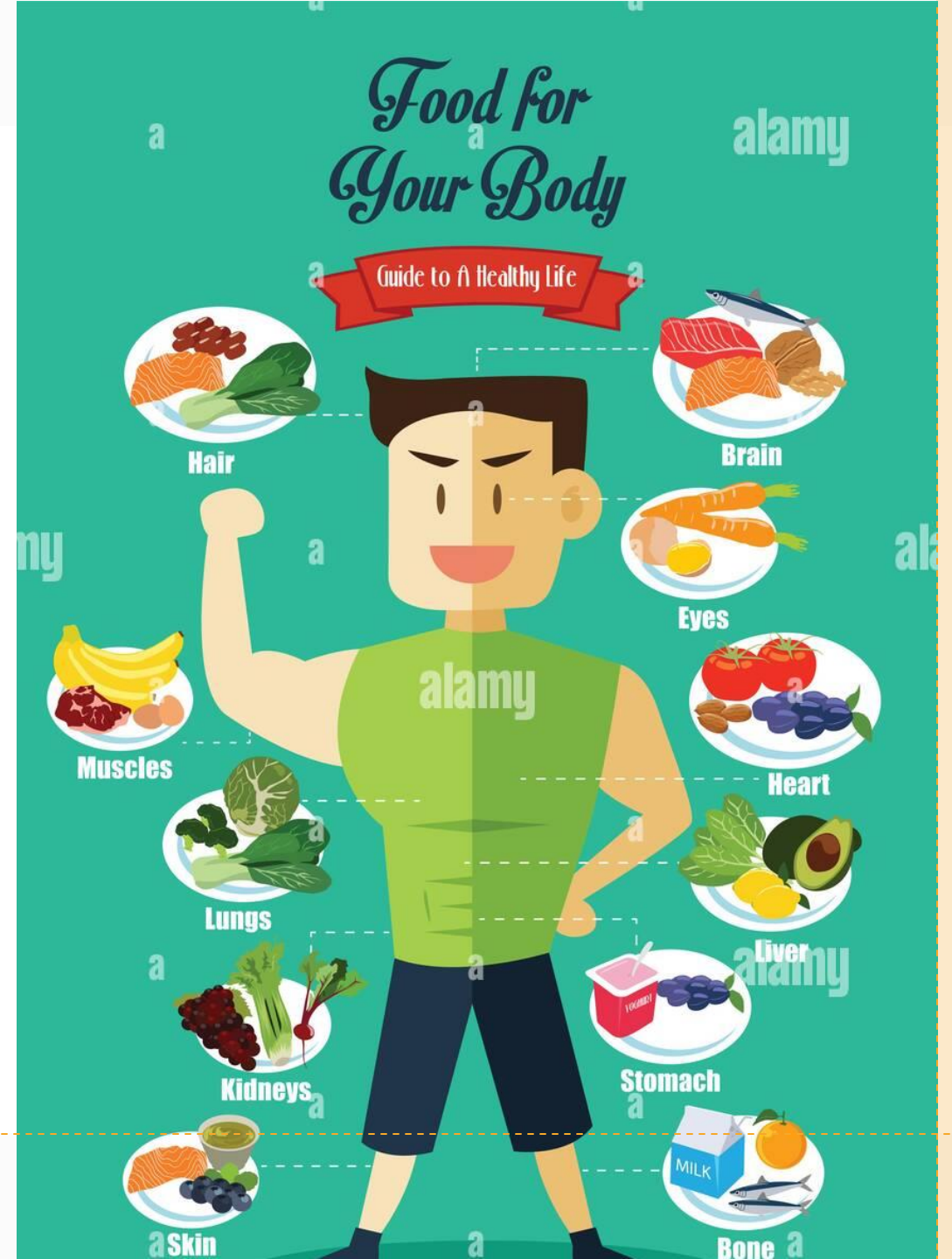
We wash our hands to keep germs away.

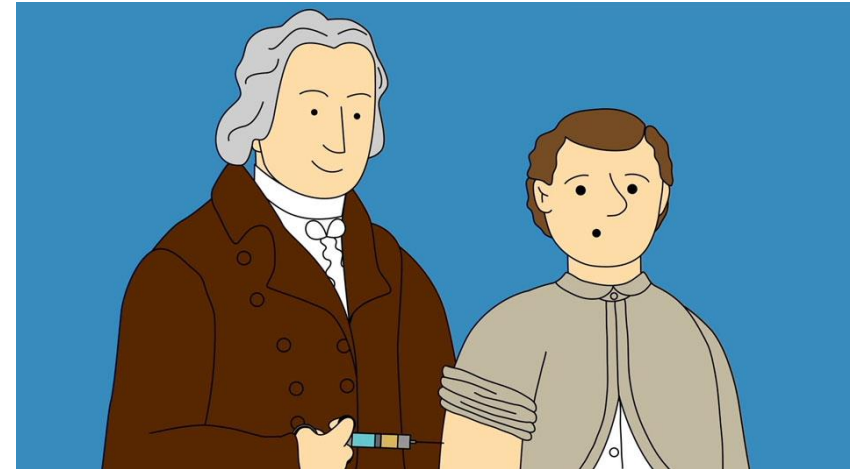
